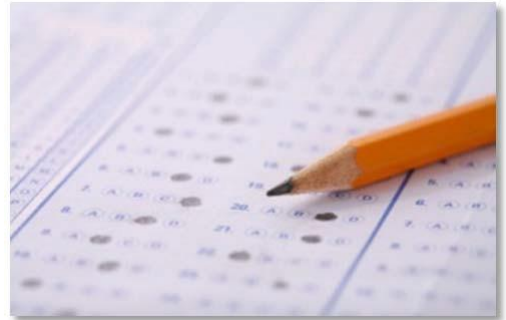
- The AAAM Board Examination process consists of two parts; a Written Exam and an Oral Exam.
- Earning AAAM Board Certification requires candidates to successfully pass all parts.
- Failing any of the two-part examination process will require candidates to retake all two parts; there is a \$500 re-sit fee.
- Written and Oral Exam scores are not reviewed with the candidate.
- Refunds to those who do not pass are not provided.

### I. WRITTEN / THEORY

**Date: 4<sup>th</sup> December 2018**

Registration: 8:00 AM

- The written exam consists of 100 multiple choice questions.
- The exam must be completed in two hours.
- Partial credit for correct answers is provided.
- Successful candidates must achieve at least 70% correct answers in order to advance to the Oral Examination.



The written exam covers the following topics presented during the AAAM Level 1 Certificate, and Level 2 Diploma Courses:

- Advanced Botox and Fillers
- Botox and Fillers
- Cosmetic Dermatology
- Lasers, IPLs and Physical Peelings
- Phlebology and Pain Management
- Sclerotherapy
- Skin Conditioning and Chemical Peels

Written/Theory exam starts at 9:00 am sharp, candidates are informed to arrive for registration not later than 8:00 am. Candidates must be seated by 8:30 am in their allotted seat in examination hall and the doors will then be closed. The duration of the exam is 2 hours.

The theory results will be announced at **1:30 pm** on the same day and the successful candidates shall be invited to attend the **oral and practical exam** on the **5<sup>th</sup> of December 2018, 9 :00 am**. ### II. ORAL EXAM

**Date: 5<sup>th</sup> December 2018**

- There will be minimum 2 examination stations where the examiner will test the knowledge and skill of the candidates using patient slides / and or cases in Aesthetic Medicine.

- Where Patient Slides/Cases are provided candidates will have 15 minutes preparatory time to Evaluate the patient conditions and shall present their assessment separately to two senior AAAM Faculty.
- The final result shall be announced at **11:30 am** on **5<sup>th</sup> of December 2018**

The successful candidates will be awarded the Board Certification in a gowning ceremony (provided by the Academy) starting at 7:00 pm. Code is formal.
