Refund Policy for American Academy of Aesthetic Medicine Courses

Note: Refunds or credits for course cancellation are not provided if the cancellation occurs within 3 weeks prior to start of the course.

- Cancellation Prior to 3 Weeks Before Course Start Date: If you cancel your registration before the 3-week deadline, a USD 250 administration charge will be deducted from your paid course registration fees.
- Transferring Credit: If you wish to transfer your credit to another AAAM event before the 3-week deadline, no fee will be deducted. However, if you request the transfer within 3 weeks of the course dates, an administration charge of USD 250 will be deducted, and you must use the credit within one year.
- **Full Forfeiture:** After the cancellation deadline (within 3 weeks of the course start date), full registration fees are forfeited, and no refund or credit will be provided.
- No-Shows: No-shows are treated as cancellations, and any refund or credit is forfeited.
- **Refund Request Process:** All refund requests must be submitted in writing to either anita@ibcme.com or lonita@ibcme.com before the stipulated date.

Refund Policy for IBC Medical Courses Except for Aesthetic Medicine Courses

The refund policy applies solely to fully paid fees. Deposits and partially paid fees are non-refundable.

- No Refund if cancelled within 6 days of the course start date.
- 7 Days before the course date 30% Refund
- 30 Days before the course date 50% Refund
- In any events a 20% administration fees will be charged for the refund prior to 30 Days.
- If you wish to transfer your credit to another IBC event within 30 days of the course date, a 20% administration fee will be deducted, and the credit must be used within one year.
- In the event IBC postpones or cancels, a full refund of the amount received in our account will be issued.
